**7-DAY NUUK AND FIORD**

# PROGRAM

## DAY 1: ARRIVAL DAY

Transfer to hotel.

Get settled in and explore on your own if time permits.

## DAY 2: GUIDED CITY TOUR AND HIKE

We start the adventure by taking you on a 1½ hour guided city tour of Nuuk. The tour takes you through the three parts of the city, showing its charming history, art and architecture.

We end the city tour at the edge of civilization, where city meets untamed, yet breathtaking wilderness. The hiking trails are quite often formed by reindeer herds, and offer beautiful fiord views, pristine streams and scenic valleys.

The hike starts north along the coastline of Nuuk, where you get a great view of the Nuup Kangia fiord system. In the fiord you'll find a spectacular view of the mountain Sermitsiaq, which serves as the unofficial signature of Nuuk. From there we move inland through Paradise Valley, which lies in between the mountains of Little Marlene and Big Marlene. The landscape is rugged terrain, with clear springs of drinkable water. We take a break here, where you can eat your food and ask our guide questions about local culture and life in Greenland. The trip ends with a beautiful walk along the lake 'Cirkussøen' and to Qinggorput, where you are picked up and transferred back to the city.

# DAY 3 -5: CAMP KANGIUSAQ

This unique concept deep in the Nuuk Fiord, offers fantastic hiking opportunities, large tents with comfortable beds and a view you can get lost in, preferably sipping a freshly brewed cup of coffee.

The camp tour starts with a sailing cruise through the ice fiord, where you will enjoy your lunch on the boat among the icebergs, and then continue to the camp.

Ever heard of FOMO, the fear of missing out? This is JOMO, the joy of missing out! The camp is completely out of cell phone range, so get a little disconnected whilst enjoying nature and its silence. If you'd like, there are ample opportunities to jump in a dry suit and go paddling with a paddleboard or kayak in our little fiord that is often graced by icebergs.

All meals are included in your stay, the dinners will be made using local ingredients, to be enjoyed family-style in our large mess tent.

We finish off the experience with a Qooqut Catch 'N' Eat tour. This tour brings you to the former settlement of Qooqut and its restaurant Qooqut Nuan. On the way to Qooqut you catch your own dinner, either Atlantic Cod or Redfish. The fish you catch are then prepared for you by the restaurant, and yes, there is a catch guarantee.

Qooqut Nuan's pier ensures your feet stay dry, and after a short walk of about 300 meters you arrive at the restaurant, boasting one of the best views of the fiord.

The sailing between Qooqut, Camp Kangiusaq and Nuuk is majestic in and of itself, and there's a good chance of spotting whales and other wildlife. You will not regret embarking on this trip of a lifetime.

# DAY 6 NATIONAL MUSEUM AND CULINARY EXPERIENCE

After a slow morning and time to digest the days in the fiord, we explore the collections of the Greenland National Museum, which covers the entire 4,500 years of Greenland's history. Delve into unique ethnographic and archaeological collections from throughout Greenland in the fascinating, permanent exhibitions.

After the National Museum, lunch is served at one of the best restaurants in Nuuk. The tasting menu embraces locally sourced produce, served in traditional ways as well as a more modern presentation.

After lunch you are free to explore Nuuk or go look for that special souvenir to bring home.
